New York State Reading Association has created this new program.

Rationale: To increase attendance and participation in future years, by encouraging attendance by new teachers/graduate students/new members. Ambassadors will be asked

to share their experience at their local council meetings (preferably general membership meeting).

Open to members of a local council who have never attended a NYSRA Annual Conference with the suggestion that special consideration given to new teachers (less than five years of teaching).

Local councils will determine the procedures for selection of person to receive full conference registration with the stipulation that the member must never have attended a NYSRA Annual Conference.

Ambassadors will receive full conference registration to the conference Number of ambassadors: 21
